



**Project Description:**

Two classrooms will be paired up and each class will create a monster using materials that can be obtained from school—bulletin board paper, poster board, construction paper, markers, cotton balls, yarn, etc. The class will then write a description of their monster and send the description to their partner class via a shared wiki page. Each class will recreate the other class' monster by following the directions from the shared wiki page. Both classes will meet via video conference to compare the original monsters with the recreated monsters. This project will enable students to improve their descriptive writing skills, use math terms, and their ability to follow directions.
